### HOW TO ENROLL IN GWC CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT COURSES

APPROXIMATE PROCESSING  
TIMELINE: 3 WEEKS

#### STEP 1

Create an  
**OpenCCC** account

**CREATE AN ACCOUNT** for California Community Colleges.

#### STEP 2

Submit an **ONLINE APPLICATION** to Golden West College

**ADMISSIONS APPLICATION:** For **new** students or students who *haven't taken a GWC course* in **3+** semesters. Find the application here:

**RETURNING STUDENTS:** If you took a class at GWC during the last **2** semesters (*excluding summer*), you may skip this step.



2 - 3 BUSINESS DAYS

#### STEP 3

Complete GWC's **CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT RELEASE FORM**

**NEW STUDENTS:** Wait 24 hours to receive a welcome email with your GWC ID, MyGWC Username and login instructions.

Use your MyGWC USERNAME and PASSWORD to access the **online concurrent enrollment form**:

- A new form must be submitted *every semester*
- Form cannot be edited after submission

*If changes need to be made, you will need to submit a new form - submission does not guarantee class space -*
