Recycling and Resource Management*

The Associate in Arts degree in Recycling and Resource Management involves satisfactory completion of a minimum of 60 semester units, including at least 18 units in the major as outlined below and fulfillment of all GWC general education requirements (21 units) and additional electives to reach the 60 units. Students must complete the major requirements in effect at the time enrollment begins, or the major requirements in effect at graduation, as long as continuous enrollment is maintained. At least 50 percent of the major units must be completed at Golden West College. Each course for the major must be completed with a grade of C (2.0) or higher.
