[EBSCOHost](#) -- Find full-text articles from scholarly journals, magazines and newspapers in thousands of periodicals on a variety of topics. EBSCOHost Mobile for Smart Phones now available.

[E-Books on EBSCOHost](#) -- Find books in full-text on a variety of subjects. These electronic books are linked to the library catalog and are searchable as "electronic book". As of 2011 there are 9000 e-books.

[SIRS](#) -- Find full-text articles, pro and con analysis, tutorials for research and PowerPoint, federal government agency reports, and authoritative websites on a variety of social sciences, humanities and current event topics.

[ProQuest Newspapers](#) -- Find current and historical full-text newspaper articles from the **Los Angeles Times, New York Times, Washington Post, Wall Street Journal and Christian Science Monitor.**

[CQ Researcher](#) -- Find in-depth research reports on current topics in health, education, the environment, technology, politics, social issues, legal issues and more. Includes pro and con perspectives, historical chronology, background information, trends and additional sources.

[ProQuest Nursing and Biology](#)

- **ProQuest Nursing and Allied Health** -- Find full-text scholarly and "continuing education" journal articles in the fields of nursing and allied health, such as pharmacology. Includes scholarly journals, magazines, trade publications, reference books, reports and dissertations.
- **Proquest Biology Journals** -- Find full-text articles from scholarly journals, magazines and trade publications in science and biology. It includes *Integrative and Comparative Biology*. Some journals require an RSS feed connection in the database. See a reference librarian for assistance.

[Country Watch](#) -- Find up-to-date and detailed information on all countries including government, history, social, economy and economic forecasts, business, environmental conditions, travel and culture and maps. Special links for elections, weekly political intelligence reports, and a daily newswire for every country in the world with a foreign news archive of regional news carriers. **Useful for MUN, history, political science, economics, business, travel, and current events.**

[Literature Resource Center](#) -- Find full-text authoritative sources in literary criticism and analysis, literary biography, and literary themes in books, scholarly journals and media sources. Advanced techniques allow you to search for persons or literary works in various categories.

[Project Muse](#) -- Find full-text scholarly academic research articles in music, art, theater, cinema, literature, deaf studies, sociology, psychology, education, history, geography, and philosophy.
On-campus only.

[World History in Context](#) -- Find information on historical movements and individuals that defined, informed and shaped world history over the last 5,000 years. Search by broad or specific topics. Provides full-text from primary sources, magazines, academic journals, newspapers, reference books, media images and audio clips. Includes curriculum standards for US federal and state and foreign countries.

[Vocational Biographies](#) -- Offers in-depth coverage of a variety of careers from across the U.S. using biographical interviews and career information.
