



**Estimated Expenses for International Students—Cosmetology**

International student tuition for the 2022-2023 academic year is \$407 USD per unit. Tuition and fees are subject to change without notice. Cosmetology is a 1000-hour program, consisting of five sessions and takes approximately one year to complete. The program offers full time day classes only, Monday thru Friday, 8:00am-4:30pm. New sessions begin in August, January. Once you start the program, you must continue enrollment consecutively until completion.
