B. **Collection of Kindness and Acts of Kindness (Information)**

Each month, Student Clubs & Organizations can participate in both the Collection of Kindness and the Acts of Kindness programs. The Collection of Kindness is a physical donation program; club members can drop off their items to Campus Life during Student Services Center operating hours (Monday – Thursday, 8:00am – 5:00pm and Fridays, 8:00am – 12:00pm). The [Acts of Kindness](#) program allows club members to submit any volunteer or community service activity to Campus Life.

At the end of each month, stipends will be awarded to clubs for 1<sup>st</sup> place (\$60); 2<sup>nd</sup> place (\$40), and 3<sup>rd</sup> place (\$20) for each program. For September, the Collection of Kindness category is unopened travel-sized personal hygiene products.

Current September totals: Collection of Kindness – CNSA (22 items); Psychology Club (2 items); Psi Beta (2 items). Acts of Kindness – no submissions.

We encourage a fun, open, and respectful forum for students of all backgrounds to participate in engaging and productive conversation while enriching their skills in public-speaking, formulating and challenging sound arguments, and collaborative effort.

- Anime Club (New Club) - The purpose of this club is to bring together a community of anime fans on the GWC campus to form great connections through this specific hobby. We will also strive to spread positivity with the power of anime itself.
- Volunteer Club (New Club) - Our purpose is to give back to the community through acts of service. The Volunteer Club is for students who want to lend a helping hand to the people and ecosystem of Huntington Beach.
- Writer’s Club (Club Reactivation pending Advisor) - This club aims to inspire writers and give them a supportive community to grow alongside, to reach their greatest potential. This club is an outlet to share and gain insight (if you want, of course!) into your stories, poems, and plays, even if you’re on a writer’s hiatus.
