

# FAQ's

## DO YOU HAVE TO PAY ANYTHING TO USE THE HEALTH CENTER?

- There is a mandatory student health fee that must be paid when you register for your classes
- There may be small fees associated with certain services or medications.

## HOW DO YOU GO ABOUT USING THE HEALTH CENTER FOR THE FIRST TIME?

You can call 714-895-8379 for an appointment, or walk in. You will have forms to fill out digitally before your scheduled appointment.

## WHAT CAN'T THE HEALTH CENTER PROVIDE?

We cannot treat any long term chronic medical condition, such as asthma, diabetes, hypertension, hormonal replacement, or any condition requiring continued medical attendance.

## WHAT HAPPENS IF I GET INJURED ON CAMPUS?

- If it's an emergency, call 911
- Report your injury (instructor/coach/public safety/student health)
- Your injury may be covered under student insurance. We will administer first aid as needed
- We may refer you to a community clinic or specialist
