4.2: Three additional Social Sciences course from: ANTH G136, G140, G150, ECON G110, 120, G170, G175, GEOG G100, G180, G185, HIST G110, HIST G136, PHIL G150, PSCI G110, G120, G130, G150, G180, G185, PSY G100, G116, G118, G165, G250, G255, SOC G100, G110, SOC 133/SOCS G133, SOC G134/ SOCS G134, SOC 185, SOSC G136.

4.3: Social Science division requires completion of MATH G160 + MATH G180, or a year-long statistics sequence after transfer (SOC SCI 10A + 10B + 10C) for the major. Students choosing to complete the year-long statistics sequence after transfer must still complete a qualifying transferable mathematics course for admission.

UCLA:

BA and BS Degree options available.

5.1: Complete either ANTH G130 or ANTH G185.

5.2: Math G180 + G185 required for BS Degree, as well as: BIOL G180 + G220, CHEM G180 + G185, CHEM G220, and MATH G160.

UC RIVERSIDE:

BA or BS Degree options available.

UC SAN DIEGO: BA Degree with options in Archeology, Biological, or Sociocultural Anthropology

6.1: Only ANTH G130 required for concentration in Archeology. Only ANTH G185 is required for concentration in Biological. Only ANTH G100 required for concentration in Sociocultural.
