UC BERKELEY: BS Degree. Admission to the Business major at Berkeley is highly competitive and open only for the FALL semester. Only applicants with 100% of the prerequisites will be considered for admission. Failure to complete required courses is the primary reason for denial of applications. All transfer applications will be asked to submit a self-reported academic record (SAR), essay and resume. **IGETC does not satisfy admission or degree requirements – Please see a GWC Counselor for specific coursework to meet breadth requirements.** 5 year recency on prerequisite coursework for major. Please see GWC Counselor for additional admission requirements for this major.

6.1: Breadth requirements cannot be doubled counted for preparation in this major.

UC IRVINE: BS Degree. Transfer applicants with the highest grades overall (minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0) and who satisfactorily complete required lower-division major requirements in Calculus (G180+G185), Economics (G170+G175), Statistics (G160) and Accounting (G101+G102) will be given preference. Students must select from a minimum of one of the following emphases: Accounting, Finance, Health Care Management, Information Systems, Marketing, Operations and Decision Technologies, and Organization and Management. Additional programs available in Business Economics.

UC RIVERSIDE: BS Degree. This major is selective based on GPA and the strength of academic preparation in the major. Minimum 2.70 GPA in UC transferable coursework, and 2.5 GPA in lower-division preparation coursework. Completion of either IGETC or the UCR Breadth Requirements required for admission. Additional programs available in Business Economics.

7.1 : Complete either CS G130 or CS G101.

7.2 : Complete either MATH G140 or MATH G180.

7.3: Advance Placement substitution: Exam scores of 3 or better on the following: a) Microeconomics exam will satisfy ECON 2 at UCR; b) Macroeconomics exam will satisfy ECON 3, and Mathematics AB Exam will satisfy MATH 9A (or AB sub score of the BC Exam); Mathematics BC Exam
