CSU Dominguez Hills: BA in Liberal Studies, BA in Liberal Studies – Early Teaching and Learning Option. All students are required to attend a Liberal Studies advising meeting immediately after transfer.

1.1: MAT 107 (GWC: MATH G104) cannot satisfy B4: Quantitative Reasoning requirement for CSU-GE.

1.2: Complete (ART G100 or THEA G100) and (MUS G101 or MUS G103, or DANC G101)

1.3: EDUC G200 is granted subject credit in lieu of the upper division course. No upper division unit credit granted.

1.4: Complete HIST G161 (preferred) or ANTH G130 to meet this requirement.

1.5: Students need to select one option in the major.

For option in ART: complete ART G100, plus three courses from ART G116 or 117, 121, 130 or 131, 142.

For Dance: complete DANC G100, G120

For Mathematics: Complete MATH G160 and G170 and MATH C106 at Coastline.

For Physical Education option: Complete PE G164 and DANC G112; and two courses from PE G186, G192, G195.

For Natural Science option: Complete GEOL G110.

1.6: Complete MATH C106 at Coastline (cannot satisfy B4: Quantitative Reasoning requirement for CSU-GE)

1.7: No upper division unit credit granted.

CSU Fullerton: BA in Liberal Studies.

2.0: Preferred GE courses.

2.1: Select one course from ENGL G143, G150, G155, G270, or G275.

a) Students selecting ENGL G143 will be given subject credit for ENGL 341 at CSUF. No upper division unit credit granted.

2.2: Complete MATH G104 in lieu of MATH 303A. Students will be given subject credit for MATH 303A at CSUF. No upper division unit credit granted.

2.3: EDUC G102+G103+G200 required for EDEL 315 credit.

2.4: Complete GEOL G106 or PHSC G100.

2.5: Complete one CSU-GE Area A3: Critical Thinking course from COMM G220, ENGL G110, or PHIL G115.

Only ENGL G110 meets AAT requirement.

2.6: Complete ART G100, MUS G101 or THEA G100.

2.7: Complete HUM C100 or HUM C110 at Coastline or HUM A100 at OCC. Subject credit awarded for CSUF's LIB STUD 300. No upper division unit credit.

CSU Long Beach: BA Liberal Studies (Track 1 and Integrated Teacher Education Option).

3.1: Select one course from ENGL G112, G150, G155, G270 or G275

3.2: Need to complete both HIST G161 and GEOG G100 for credit in this major.

3.3: Complete one course from DANC G101, THEA G100/HUM G132, THEA G106

3.4: Select one course from: PHIL G100, G102, G120

3.5: Complete one CSU-GE A3: Critical Thinking course from COMM G220, ENGL G110, or PHIL G115

3.6: No upper division unit credit awarded.

3.7: Complete MATH C106 at Coastline.

3.8: Complete MUS G115 at GWC.
