UC BERKELEY: BA History

- 5.1: Select one course in US History
- 5.2: Select one course in Western Civilizations
- 5.3: Elective: Select one additional course from US History, Western Civilizations, or any other history course such as Women's History or California History.

UC IRVINE: BA History

- 6.1: Select two courses from two different regions. A third course will be required at UCI.
- 6.2: Select up to four additional history courses from: ANTH G136/HIST G136, ECON G120/HIST G110, HIST G120, G121, G132, G135, G140, G150, G161, G162, G170, G175, G180/185H, 185/G185H
- 6.3: All students must complete a "Humanities Core". Students can select from either HUMAN 1A + 1AS + 1B + 1BS + 1C + 1CS at UCI, or (a) one writing course from ENGL G100/G100H or ENGL G110/G110H, (b) One additional literature course selected from ENGL G112, G150, G155, G160, G160H, G161, G161H, G270, G275 (if not already used in 5.1), (c) one History course from: HIST G120, G150, G161, G162, G170, G175, G180, G185, and (d) One Philosophy course from: PHIL G100, G102, G120, PHIL G150/PSCI G150.
- 6.4: Students must complete coursework equivalent to the fourth college semester of a foreign language. Select any language course at G285-level.

UCLA: BA History

- 7.1: Select one course from HIST G161, G162, G180, G185.
- 7.2: Select two courses from: HIST G110, G120, G121, G132, G135, G136, G140, G150, G160, G170, G175

UC RIVERSIDE: BA History

- 8.1: Complete two lower division History courses. One course must be in world history. HIST G161, G162.
- 8.2: If selecting a concentration in US History, complete HIST G170 + G175.

UC SAN DIEGO:

Department fields are as follows: Africa, East Asia, Europe, Near East, Latin America, History of Science, and United States history; as well as, the following three thematic fields: Gender and Sexuality; Race, Ethnicity, and Migration; and War, Revolution, and Social Change. Three quarter courses or two semester courses are required for lower division.

HISTORY MAJOR ADVISEMENT

9.1: Courses including World History/Western Civilization that have not been Articulated must be approved via petition on an individual basis by the History department upon transfer.
