CSU DOMINGUEZ HILLS: RN-BSN Program only. Must have Associate Degree in Nursing + valid RN license for BSN degree completion program.

CSU FULLERTON: Upper division transfer students in Pre-Nursing suspended until further notice. **RN-BSN Program Admission Requirements.**

Students must meet requirements for admission to the university as a transfer student; have an associate degree in nursing or its equivalent and current licensure as a Registered Nurse in California. Completion of college level prerequisite courses with a minimum "C" grade or better in each course listed.

2.1 Complete either CHEM G110 or CHEM G130 or CHEM G180

2.2: Accelerated BSN and Entry-Level MSN programs available for those who have already earned a BA/BS Degree in another discipline. See <http://nursing.fullerton.edu/programs> for more information.

CSULONG BEACH: All nursing programs at this campus are impacted. Please see counselor for admission and selection criteria for this major. Two options available: Nursing – Basic Pre-licensure, and Nursing – Registered Nurse (RN-BSN with an Associate Degree in Nursing and a valid California RN License). Admission to the nursing major in the School of Nursing requires a separate application. All students subject to criminal background check, health insurance, immunizations, medical clearance, and malpractice insurance are required for clinical coursework.

CSU LOS ANGELES: All nursing programs at this campus are impacted. Please see counselor for admission and selection criteria for this major. Two options available: Nursing – Basic Pre-licensure and RN Transfer (RN-BSN with an Associate Degree in Nursing and a valid California RN License). Admission to the nursing major in the School of Nursing requires a separate application obtained in the School of Nursing advisement office. Pre-licensure requires a minimum 2.75 GPA for consideration. 3.1: One course in nutrition required for this major. Complete HLED G135

3.2: Accelerated BSN and Entry-Level MSN programs available for those who have already earned a BA/BS Degree in another discipline. Requires additional coursework of PSYC G118 and HLED G135. Minimum 3.0 GPA for consideration. See http://www.calstatela.edu/academic/hhs/nursing/ELM_adm.php

CSU SAN MARCOS: BS Nursing has four options: Traditional BSN (Generic/Basic), LVN-BSN, RN-BSN, Accelerated BSN (for students with prior BA/BS in another discipline). UC IRVINE: Admission to the major is limited and selective. Junior-level applicants with the highest grades overall and who satisfactorily complete course prerequisites will be given preference for admission to the Nursing Science major. *Applicants must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher to be considered, minimum "B" grades in the following:* All courses listed above, plus genetics equivalent to UCI's Biological Sciences 97; biochemistry equivalent to UCI's Biological Sciences 98; human physiology with lab equivalent to UCI's BIOSCI E109 + E112L; human anatomy with lab equivalent to UCI's NURSCI 100 + 100L; one quarter/semester of public health equivalent to UCI's PUBHLTH 1. Please see a counselor for exact course equivalents.

6.1: Approved for subject credit and lower division credit for the Nursing Science major only.

6.2: Select one course from: PSYC G100, G250, or G255.

6.3: Select one course from: SOC G100/G100H, SOC G110, SOC G185, ANTH G100

6.3: Major requires PHIL G120: Ethics.

6.4: Select one statistics course from: MATH G160 or BIOL G260

6.5: Coursework equivalent to BIOSCI 97, 98 available at OCC: BIOL A281, BIOL A283. Additional course in Public Health (PUBHLTH 1) required at UCI. See counselor for options on completing this course prior to transfer.

UCLA: This is a three year program. Minimum 3.5 GPA in all UC-Transferable coursework required. Applicants to the nursing program must complete a supplementary application with the School of Nursing which includes two letters of recommendation from appropriate sources, a statement of purpose, completion of IGETC. The Nursing/Prelicensure program is not open to second baccalaureate applicants. Students with a non-nursing baccalaureate degree should apply for the Masters Entry Clinical Nurse (MSN/MECN) program. Minimum "C" grade in each course required, and overall 3.5 GPA in all UC-transferable coursework.

Biola University: Programs available in Basic/Pre-licensure. Program requires secondary application to the Department of Nursing. Priority placement given to those with a minimum 3.3 GPA form all colleges attended, and minimum 3.0 in required sciences.
