	<ul> <li>Education Protection Account</li> </ul>
	Highlights:
	<ul> <li>Spending more than received is mostly due to an increase in salary and benefits. This is a historic pattern.</li> <li>23-24 State budget reduction is used to support the 8.22% COLA</li> <li>Flexibility of use of categorical program funding (one-time funds) ie- CCOVID Blick Grant, Recovery &amp; Enrollment, and Scheduled Maintenance/Instructional Equipment</li> <li>GWC Fine Arts renovation program is funded but only design activities are authorized. Construction is delayed until a new State Bond is approved.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Enrollment declines in recent years</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>District is developing a Fiscal Stabilization Plan jointly with the Colleges to ensure sufficient reserves are maintained (3 year plan from 2023-26).</li> </ul>

	<ul> <li>Utilities have increased drastically (Lottery money funded this) Jan/Feb/March was greater than previous 6 months.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>HERRF relief funding is gone</li> </ul>
	Negative line item was adjusted by our Fund Balance
	What we can't cover with revenue comes out of our fund
	balance
	<ul> <li>Restricted Lottery provided funding</li> <li>Out of state students provided a small bump</li> </ul>
