REPORTS & UPDATES (maximum of 5 minutes per report)

1. Articulation report – Nicole Diamond

Four courses not UCTCA approved. Three of the four can be resubmitted. There is an open ticket regarding the ECON courses in ASSIST due to reactivation issues. The CJ course was denied for lack of theory and research. Nicole can work with CJ. Nicole is working with MUS and will resubmit in October. PE G131 has a reactivation delay and plan to resubmit it next June since it is effective Fall 2025. Jennifer will speak with Nicole regarding the PE course number as PE G131 is a retired Karate course so the number cannot be used for Intermediate Yoga as currently intended. Cal-GETC submissions are in December and the results are in mid-May. Nicole can only reach out to the universities for articulation by major (AAM) after the UCTCA results. Faculty can also reach out to those departments in universities to give a heads up AAM requests are going out. A number of private schools are now in ASSIST.

1. Ethnic Studies courses not approved in CSU GE Area F

There are two recommendations to not have students impacted by completing a course thinking it will satisfy Area F

- Retire the Ethnic Studies course prefix that did not receive Area F but keep the cross-listed courses that are commonly Area D approved and/or
- Work with the AO to resubmit for Area F approval

Ethnic Studies course prefixes that are not Area F approved are currently not scheduled. The 2023 Minimum Qualifications Handbook has a draft for Ethnic Studies and the final should be announced soon. Please consider these approaches – retire the ETHS or revise and not offer it while pending Area F approval.

2. Review of overlapping curriculum with the proposed new course, COUN G200 – Student Identity Development (Laura Duvall) The Psychology Department appreciates the Counseling Department and recognizes how curriculum has evolved over time. Psychology is interested in collaborating with the Counseling Department. After review,

Psychology has discovered OCC has PSYC A220 - Psychology of Personality that seem to cover similar material as COUN G200. It is the Psychology's opinion that an Identity course is an upper-level course. Psychology believes COUN G200 is not an Area D course as it is, but with modifications it could be an Area D course (housed in Psychology), and is more of a Psychology course rather than a counseling course.

3. Curriculum Committee Member Training

 City of Huntington Beach reached out for Criminal Justice to create the certificate. It is recommended the department discuss/collaborate with Physical Education/Athletics Department as the curriculum may already exist and consider the faculty with the FSA to write the curriculum. The program is intended to have the agency teach the curriculum, not by GWC faculty. This already exists within the community so it would be beneficial for the students to receive credit. Students may benefit in CPL within GWC or Fire if we decide to have in the future.

New GWC Program form will be revised soon.
