- 2. Chairs report Jennifer Bailly The college and district were previously non-compliant with Title 5 regulations regarding activity courses. Activity courses (e.g., physical education, dance, music, studio art) have now been organized into "families" across the district. The rule is that students can only repeat courses within the same family, or up to four courses within that family. This system has been implemented in Banner, and the list of courses is extensive. The next step is to review and potentially present these families at an upcoming meeting to ensure alignment and clarity on the changes.

ASCCC Plenary is this week and one of the colleges requested the resolution of putting a hold on the CCN process. GWC Academic Senate asked for CCl's vote. CCl supports the resolution and expresses concerns about the lack of faculty involvement in the CCN process. They note that only a small number of faculty were consulted across all 116 community colleges. Although surveys were sent for Batch 2, there's uncertainty about the response rate and whether feedback is considered. The speaker is frustrated that previous input on related legislation (AB 928 and AB 1111) seemed ignored. They also question why CSU and UC systems weren't involved in the process, especially since CCN impacts transfer and graduation. Concerns are raised about the appropriateness of the implementation team and their chosen assessment language, which may not align with current teaching practices. There's worry that future templates will impose more questionable standards.
