There's a need for better coordination between nursing faculty, counseling, and the Board of Registered Nursing (BRN) to ensure the correct courses are approved. The incorrect course choices have led to a "broken degree" that prevents students from completing their program. The counseling department and nursing faculty will meet to clarify and fix the issues before the next reading. There was also a mention of ensuring prerequisites are listed correctly in the certificates, particularly for courses like Human Anatomy, which must be listed as a prerequisite for other nursing courses. The next steps involve fixing the cross-listings, correcting course selections, and ensuring all prerequisite courses are properly documented. The discussion also includes future steps to ensure that these issues are addressed before the second reading in the spring.
