  - a. Topic 1

Pre-approve ACUE course **Fostering a Culture of Belonging for Alternative methods**. This microcredential equips administrators, faculty, and staff with actionable practices they can immediately implement to contribute to whole-campus reform and ensure all students and colleagues feel seen, heard, and valued. T

 The 8-week (40 hour) course is offered online either starting May 20 or July 19. You could get 2-units of Alternative methods pay (36 hours) for taking this course. (Max currently defined by IPD)

#### b. Topic 2

However, you would have to pay for the course fee yourself, \$675, so can IPD discuss whether or not to also allow payment of fee for this class in addition to the 2 unit stipend? Reason: Steep Fee prevents folks from attending. Course Specifically Aligns with Strategic Plan Goals and encourages more senior faculty on Column 5 to complete diversity training, fostering a more friendly campus.
