1. ANNOUNCEMENTS

- A. Meeting modality Chair Green reported that emergency measures will end on February 28th and Brown Act committees will resume in person by March 1st. She announced that IPD meetings will meet in LRC 250 from 1:15pm – 2:15pm starting with the March 2nd meeting.
- B. Rep. Krause reported on her recent attendance of webinar All About the Money: An Overview of Predatory Publishing. A <u>checklist</u> on how to avoid predatory conferences was added to the <u>General</u> <u>Education/Teaching conference page</u>.

2. APPROVAL OF THE AGENDA AND MINUTES

- A. Agenda February 2, 2023. Chair Green requested to add New Business Item E, Salary Advancement Review application. MOTION by Rep. LaMantia to approve the agenda as amended. Seconded by Rep. Wegter. Hearing no objections, the agenda was approved.
- B. <u>Minutes</u> December 15, 2022. MOTION by Rep. LaMantia to approve the minutes as presented. Seconded by Rep. Wegter. Hearing no objections, the agenda was approved.

3. CONTINUING & UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

- A. 2021-25 Strategic Plan Areas of Focus for IPD: Goal #6 Professional Development GWC will support the success of all employees by providing professional development opportunities that focus on the achievement of College Goals.
 - 1. Strategy #2 Provide new Professional Development Opportunities for all college personnel including workshops that unite the campus community (Faculty, Staff and Administration), mentoring and leadership opportunities.
 - Chair Green reviewed the new changes to the IPD website. She asked the committee to refer faculty to the website as a great resource to understand all the available IPD services to eligible faculty. Committee members were asked to email Rep. Krause links to discipline and general education/teaching conferences.

2. Strategy #3 - Increase awareness of funding opportunities available and seek additional funding sources for those opportunities.

The IPD website details funding opportunities for conferences, salary advancement credits and alternative methods. Chair Green requested IPD members email Alana Krause links to their discipline conferences for posting on the IPD website. She reported that she will lead a Flex Day on alternative methods and Rep. Krause volunteered to host a session on salary advancement.

 - A. <u>Fall 2022 Sabbatical Report</u> Jennifer Bailly, Economics Jennifer Bailly reported on her sabbatical leave.
 - B. Academic Rank Proposed example of Campus announcement of promotions to Professor. [LINK] Chair Green demonstrated the Indiana University webpage that highlights faculty members promoted in Academic Rank. She recommended the AR work group create something similar for the IPD website.

 - 1. <u>Travel Ban Statement</u> Request for approval of travel to a prohibited state under AB 1887 Chair Green informed that additional states were added to the list of prohibited states. She reminded that faculty wishing to travel to these states must sign a travel ban statement.
 - ASCCC Conferences The Academic Senate and IPD encourages eligible faculty to attend conferences offered by the state Academic Senate. Apply at least six weeks in advance to have your registration prepaid. Funding is provided separately from the faculty's discipline conferences allowance and the general education/teaching conferences allowance.
