B. <u>BP 7910 Professor Emeritus</u> - Review IPD application procedure

Chair Green informed of the District's board policy regarding the designation of Emeritus for employees. She states to have contacted HR for clarification on their process but has not received a reply.

- In question was whether HR would be responsible for handling this on behalf of faculty due to the redundancy of the IPD office having to contact them to confirm eligibility by verifying their years of full-time teaching.
- It was noted to confirm if District had an administrative policy and to bring to the attention of the Academic Senate representatives on the DCC BP/AP Subcommittee if needed.

- It was requested to ask District to define the eligibility of those "resigning from the District".
- Chair Green will follow up with HR and provide an update at the next meeting.

IV. NEW BUSINESS

- A. Strategic Plan Committee Areas of Focus <u>IPD goals and action report Updated Fall 2023</u> Chair Green reviewed the IPD's Strategic Plan Committee Goals and Action Report which included data from Fall 2022 to the present including the number of processed applications and the number of faculty served. She will submit this update to the Office of Instruction and another update is due Spring 2024.
