- Chair Green reported on the increase in predatory conferences and states a faculty member rescinded their international conference as it was deemed a predatory conference.

III. CONTINUING & UNFINISHED BUSINESS

A. IPD Budget update

Chair Green reviewed the current conference balances and budget transfers to subsidize the full-time conference account and general education conference account using funds from the part-time conference account. She reported there is enough alternative methods funding to approve five more applications.

B. Professor Emeritus process

Chair Green informed she spoke to HR and confirmed the IPD Professor Emeritus designation differs from the HR process. They issue an emeritus designation to employees, and the IPD designates a "professor" emeritus designation. The IPD will continue to oversee their internal process.

C. 2024-25 Sabbatical Leave update

Sabbatical Leave Chair LaMantia informed that all four applications received IPD and college president approval and will be submitted for board approval.
