A. Fall 2023 IPD Budget (includes agenda items) Chair Green reviewed the remaining account balances.

IV. NEW BUSINESS

- A. SALARY ADVANCEMENT CREDITS CCCD Accessibility Course Review (ACR)
 - Chair Green shared that faculty selected for the Accessibility Course Review (ACR) may possibly earn a stipend. She proposed whether the IPD would like to consider offering SAC in lieu of the stipend. Following a brief discussion, the IPD agreed to follow past practice with the Canvas trainings and approve (2) SAC for a max of (36) hours for completion of the ACR for the spring semester and also accept retro applications for Fall 2023. The IPD office will contact the Online Instruction office to request a list of faculty that completed the ACR. **MOTION** by Rep. Stone to approve the proposal. Seconded by Rep. LaMantia. Hearing no objections, the proposal to offer SAC was approved. Chair Green clarified the ACR would not qualify for Alternative Methods.

Addendum: Dean Miranda has since confirmed that a stipend was not offered.
