DIRECTOR OF LEGISLATIVE AFFAIRS

[Council Report]

- ASG Town hall is all confirmed and ready to go, the questions and script for ME was also approved on Tuesday (last week?). The Town Hall is on Monday, February 23, from 11:00 am - 12:30 pm in the Regional Criminal Justice Training Center
- I attended the clothing swap for a bit with Jess, amazing turn out
- Our legislative affairs committee had their first meeting on the 11th, we did introductions and were introduced to our new focus of this semester, which are the resolution packet. This upcoming week, we will be electing a new Vice Chair

- I will be receiving the resolution packet (possibly) today and will be distributing the resolutions among my committee

[Participatory Governance]

- Presidents cabinet

- facilities plan 2024, if they wanted to do anything that involved rebuilding tear down or anything to buildings, it would be around \$915 million, they're looking to remodel Fine Arts, Performing Arts and PE which would be around \$100 million

- They were also thinking of the health building, as there's a lot of students who either go there or attend classes there, which would also be around \$150 million and they were thinking of having a private fund for it

- We were tasked with making a prioritization to get the highest amount of a bond and what logistically should the building be prioritized for rebuilding

- Planning for planning committee

- one goal is for chancellor and state goals be integrated and what that basically means is that GWC will be attempting to increase enrollment with outreach and pipeline for dual enrollment

- another goal is for faculty training and having them have equity minded services and increasing academic programs, i think they were talking about the allocations of funds for different academic departments and who was getting what certain amount of money

- They gave project updates and mentioned the Tet Festival that happened around a week ago, and the Solar project is moving really quickly and they'll be moving forward with Phase II on May 1st.

- Sccc meeting on February 12 (Region VIII sponsored 5 resolutions and we got a bit of practice on reading over

resolutions) and February 15 (we looked back at the allocations of funds to sponsor people to go to GA, only 2 people were sponsored)

- There will be one more meeting on the 27th to elect a new Vice Chair for Region VIII

- I will be attending the special meeting for DSC today and DSC next week

- It was also brought up to my attention from counselors that GWC is the only school within our district that is limiting students to one degree even though students have a legal right to earn multiple degrees per catalog and with CPOS, there's still some trouble with students regarding their financial aid
