Finance Code.III.Budgets.V.Accounting.C.Expenditures.7; the request has been held for a minimum of one week for review and consideration by the Council who first heard the

request on April 7, 2023. In addition, a recommendation from the Finance Commission will be presented to the Student Council before any action is taken.
