Did you know....?

Getting your first internship is key to unlocking the earning potential of a high growth industry like tech. Students who choose a career in tech VS a median job in LA County earn an average \$2M more over their lifetime. The effect this has on individuals, families and communities as a whole is truly transformative.
