Interested in Taking a GWC Dual Enrollment Class at a HBUHSD School? Follow these steps to sign up:



Create an Open CCC Account for California Community Colleges

Students who have previously submitted a GWC application will need to log in to their existing Open CCC Account.

Submit the Online Application to Golden West College

Only students who have taken a GWC class in the fall or spring semester within the last 12 months do not need to re-apply (summer students do not need to re-apply for the fall). **Note: it takes 1-2 days to receive the GWC welcome email with the student's GWC ID number and MyGWC username and password.**

Complete the GWC Dual Enrollment Consent Form

Students need to submit the DE Consent Form <u>once</u> while they are in high school to get permission to take a GWC course at their school.

Students will use their MyGWC username and password to access the online form. Students who don't know them or haven't received them can email the GWC Dual Enrollment Office at dualenrollment@gwc.cccd.edu for assistance. Parents will need to create a Dynamic Forms account to log in and sign the electronic release form.
