Below are some resources for CARE students in addition to EOPS Services!

Gas Card Voucher

CARE student will receive a \$100.00 gas card at the end of each month. Must complete one workshop per month prior to receiving a gas card. Students will pick up the gas card in the CARE office, located on the 2nd floor of the Student Services Center. Must present your ID when you pick up the card. An e-mail will be sent when the gas card is ready for pick up.

CARE Supply Voucher -will be added to CARE Grant

Each CARE student will receive a supply voucher once per semester to be used at the GWC bookstore. Once you are approved for the CARE program, complete the CARE orientation and sign CARE Contract, your name will be submitted to the bookstore. Supply voucher must be spent prior to the end of the semester. Please read supply voucher hand out for more information on what's allowable to purchase.

CARE Unmet Need Grant

Eligible CARE students will receive a State CARE Grant for fall 2025. Student must have met the requirements for both EOPS & CARE. To receive the CARE grant students must complete three EOPS counselor appointments, two contacts with the CARE Specialist, four workshop and four activities. Also, student must have an unmet need with Financial Aid and have not drop below 50% of units attempted.
