#### Below are resources for CARE students in addition to EOPS Services!

#### **Gas Card Voucher**

CARE student will receive a \$100.00 gas card each month.

Students will pick up the gas cards in the BURSARS office, located on the first floor of the Student Services Center.

Must present your ID when you pick up the cards. An e-mail will be sent when the gas card is ready for pick up.

#### **CARE Supply Voucher**

Each CARE student will receive a \$100.00 supply voucher, once per semester to be used at the GWC bookstore. Once you are approved for the CARE program and complete the CARE orientation your name will be submitted to the bookstore. Supply voucher must be spent prior to the end of the semester. Please read supply voucher hand out for more information on what's allowable to purchase.

#### **CARE Unmet Need Grant**

Eligible CARE students will receive a CARE Grant for spring 2024. Student must have met the requirements for EOPS & CARE. To receive the CARE grant students must complete three EOPS counselor appointments, two contacts with the CARE Specialist, four workshop and four activities. Also, student must have an unmet need with Financial Aid and have not drop below 50% of units attempted.
