New Classes and Certificate!

Academic Transitional English Language Learning

This transitional English certificate provides an opportunity for multilingual students to experience the Academic English rigor introduced in the credit ESL certificates. Students will develop academic language skills in reading, writing, listening, and speaking. In addition, students will be introduced to academic habits, learning strategies, and social skills necessary to enhance their prerequisite academic knowledge. Upon completion, students will be able to build a stronger foundation for success in their transitional English language level.

ELL G040N – Introduction to Academic Writing for Multilingual Students

This course is an introduction to the ESL Academic Writing sequence for multilingual students who have no prior knowledge of Academic Writing. It is designed to strengthen basic student writing by focusing on usage, mechanics, and sentence development.

ELL G041N – Introduction to Academic Listening and Speaking for Multilingual Students

This course is an introductory course to the ESL Academic Listening and Speaking sequence for multilingual students that need proficiency in Academic English. It will familiarize students to academic listening, speaking, language, and critical thinking skills. Students will locate main ideas and details in recorded short lectures, improve pronunciation, and develop oral presentation skills.
