FREE CAREER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION PROGRAM

Automotive Safety

Students will learn about Personal Protection Equipment (PPE), how to safely use and maintain automotive tools, vehicle hoists, and other equipment used in the industry. In addition, students will take the S/P2 (Safety and Pollution Prevention) safety test which outlines proper procedures for hazardous waste handling and disposal.

Automotive Lube Technician

This course covers fundamental theories and skills required to enterthe automotive workforce as an Automotive Lube Technician. Upon completion, students will learn basic automotive safety, become proficient in using published and online vehicle service information platforms, and perform vehicle service procedures outlined by periodic maintenance schedules.

Automotive Tire and Wheel Service

Basic theory and skills required to work as a tire technician are covered in this course. Students will learn guidelines for aftermarket wheel and tire replacement, as well as the safe use of equipment for repairing and replacing tires on most light trucks and passenger vehicles.

Smog Check Inspector Level 1

This course provides students with the procedural knowledge, skills, and abilities needed to perform Smog Check inspections. Course content includes safety, customer awareness, program administration, equipment maintenance, and inspection and testing procedures for OIS and ASM smog tests. Students who complete and pass this course will have met the Bureau's training requirements to qualify for the Smog Check Inspector state licensing examination.

MORE FREE PROGRAMS COMING SOON!

SENIOR HEALTHCARE TECHNICIAN – COMING SUMMER of 2023

This program focuses primarily on the elderly population's health and safety, which may include their daily bathing and grooming tasks. The technician will perform routine vital sign monitoring, be able to perform basic CPR, assist patients to prevent falls, assist with dressing changes, and support with taking medications. This certificate program will allow the graduate to gain employment in assisted living, residential, and memory care facilities.

COMPUTER BUSINESS APPLICATIONS – COMING FALL of 2023

Introduction to Keyboarding

Students are taught keyboarding skills which are essential to learn other computer applications and to perform other essential tasks on a computer. Students will learn correct finger and hand positioning, seating and posture for efficient keyboarding.

Introduction to Computers

This course provides students with an introduction to computer hardware and software fundamentals, terminology, file management, and basic Windows operating system features. Prior computer experience is not required.

SECURITY GUARD CERTIFICATION – COMING FALL of 2023

This program is designed for individuals who want to become licensed security guards. Students are trained according to the requirements in section 7583.6(b) of the California Business and Professions Code. Students will learn arrest laws, roles and responsibilities of security guards, de-escalation tactics, civil and criminal liability issues, terrorism awareness, and information sharing responsibilities. Successful completion allows students to register as security guards and take the Powers of Arrest test required for certification as a guard.
