Golden West College is now offering fall registration for GED classes that begin August 28, 2023. Students can enroll in HyFlex classes, which means students have the option to join inperson or live online preparation courses for the GED test subjects.

The flexible class options are designed to help students attain high school equivalency credentials while maintaining work and personal commitments. Earning a GED credential can have a life-changing impact on learners. More than 20 million GED graduates worldwide, and nearly all employers and colleges accept the GED credential. GED grads can make, on average, \$9,000 more per year than individuals without a high school credential.

This GED test preparation program prepares students to succeed on the GED exams. Students will prepare for the GED exam in all four areas: Social Studies, Science, Language Arts, and Mathematics. The courses provide pre- and post-testing of each subject content and individualized prescriptive instruction in preparation for the test.


