## PREPARE TO BE A CERTIFIED NURSE ASSISTANT

### Get a jump start on your healthcare career!

Becoming a Certified Nurse Assistant is an excellent way to start a career in the healthcare industry, as it is a foundational step for those interested in pursuing a career in nursing or other healthcare professions.

The Certified Nurse Assistant program prepares students to work as entry-level healthcare workers for patients in various healthcare settings such as hospitals, long-term care facilities, and rehabilitation centers. It consists of 60 theory hours and 100 clinical hours. This course meets Title 22 regulations for caring for the senior population in hospitals, assisted living, and long-term care settings, utilizing skills in basic care, emergency care, and communication.

Upon completing the program, the student is eligible to take the Competency Evaluation Examination to become a licensed Certified Nurse Assistant. This program is designed to meet the curriculum requirement of the California Department of Public Health (CDPH).

### Program Prerequisites:

- Must have valid government-issued picture ID and United States Social Security (SSN) or Individual Taxpayer Identification Number (ITIN)
- Must have health insurance
- Attend a Mandatory Information Session – scan the QR code to sign up. (GWC Student ID required.)
- Be 16 years of age or older
- Complete health screening requirements\*
- Complete/clear drug screen and background check\*
