CASTING

NOTE: This production contains partial adult nudity for some characters, adult language, and adult situations, and is intended for mature audiences. All characters except Mason are baseball players. Experience playing baseball not required but is helpful.

All roles open.

Darren Lemming – any age to play male 25-35. Lead role. Handsome, fit and very famous center fielder for the Empires. Biracial with a white father and a black mother. Supremely self-confidence and entitled.

Mason Marzac – any age to play male 25-37. Lead role. Investment/financial advisor assigned to manage Darren Lemming's finances. Nerdy accountant who finds a love for baseball.

Kippy Sunderstrom: any age to play male 25-35. Lead role. Acts as the play's narrator, directly addressing the audience and providing context. Darren Lemming's closest friend on the Empires. Intelligent, friendly.

Shane Mungitt - any age to play male 22-28. Lead role. Exceptional pitcher for the Empires. Lacks intelligence and polish. Orphan who reflects the values of those who ran the orphanage. Generally disliked by the entire team.

Toddy Koovitz -- any age to play male 25-35. Supporting role. A player for the Empires. Illiterate. Warns Darren that his significance to the team as a player won't shield him from divine retribution.

Skipper: any age to play male 40 -55. Supporting role. Manager of the Empires. Recognized for his people skills, balancing toughness with gentleness when needed.

Davy Battle - any age to play male 27-37. Supporting role. Darren Lemming's closest friend, a standout player on another team and overall good person. Middle-class family man.

Jason Chenier -- any age to play male 25-35. Supporting role. Catcher with the Empires. Shy, awkward.

Takeshi Kawabata - any age to play male 25-35. Supporting role. Japanese/Asian. Empires' star pitcher. Must be able to speak text written in both Japanese and English. If not a native speaker, will be taught text phonetically.

Rodriguez - any age to play male 25-35. Baseball player for the Empires. Must speak Spanish and English text. If not a native speaker, will be taught text phonetically.

Martinez - any age to play male 25-35. Baseball player for the Empires. Must speak Spanish and English text. If not a native speaker, will be taught text phonetically.

Auditions:

Sides will be available for each character two weeks before the audition date at [GWC Performing Arts](#) under Theater Auditions halfway down the home page on the left side. No monologue required.

There will be additional cold readings as well. Bring a picture/resume.

Auditions will be held in Stage West at Golden West College, 15751 Gothard Street at Center Avenue, Huntington Beach. Enter the campus from the Gothard Street side near the Mainstage Theater. Stage West is opposite the Mainstage Theater. Parking is free in the Gothard Street parking lot "J" near the Amphitheater/ Boys and Girls Club.

Rehearsals begin on Thursday September 3 and are scheduled for Monday through Thursday evenings from 7 pm until 10:00 pm. Cast members are called to rehearsals only when needed.
