Purpose

The Barber City Women's Club of Westminster (BCWC) Scholarship Award was created to assist deserving women residing in the City of Westminster/Midway City who wish to continue their education, whether through a vocational program or a college/university path, and intend to foster a commitment to serving their community. There will be three (3) Scholarships awarded for this application year.

Eligibility

Applications will be reviewed by the Selection Committee to identify women who embody the purpose of the BCWC.

- Applicant must reside in the City of Westminster or Midway City
 - Applicant may be a high school senior, an incoming/current college/university student, or a vocational student
 - Applicant must provide proof of current/upcoming enrollment as a full-time student in any of the following institutions: an accredited community college (12 semester units or more), an accredited 4-year college/university (12 semester units or more), or a vocational or licensing program (full time track)
 - Applicant must be available for a personal interview by the Selection Committee, if requested

- Completed and signed application
 - Copy of photo identification (driver license or school ID)
 - Proof of current/upcoming enrollment (e.g. acceptance letter, course schedule, or other proof of full-time attendance)
 - List of volunteer/community service activities, memberships in clubs or professional organizations, awards/recognitions, and any other activity that demonstrates service (include a description of your role)
 - Personal statement that includes a brief introduction and background, future educational goals, future/career life goals, and future service goals (statement should use specific details and examples and be between 300-500 words in length). Include word count.

Only complete applications will be considered. To be complete, the application submitted must include all of the Required Documentation listed above.
