GWC Student-Athletes Return to Campus for Conditioning

n November 2, 2020, the Golden West College student-athletes and coaches were approved to come on campus for outdoor conditioning. Following stringent health guidelines and divided into cohort groups, each team has a specific parking area and path to enter and leave campus as to not overlap with other programs (minimizing extra contact). This is the first time the teams have been together since the campus closure on March 12.

These outdoor conditioning practices will prepare our studentathletes to begin their seasons of competition in late January 2021. On July 9, 2020, the California Community College Athletic Association (CCCAA) approved a contingency plan to move the traditional fall season to begin on January 18, and push the traditional spring season start to March. We will have men's and women's basketball, men's and women's cross country, football, men's and women's soccer, women's volleyball, and men's and women's water polo practices starting on January 18 with competitions beginning on February 5. All programs will play a shortened season of 70% of their normal schedules.

At this time, attendance at these contests will be limited to the student-athletes, coaches, and essential personnel only. However, the Athletics Division is working to have a majority of the contests live-streamed through the GWC Athletics website and GWC Athletics YouTube channel.
