Welcome to Camp!

You may have seen or heard that word around the virtual campus recently. What exactly is CaMP? We asked the two CaMP leaders, Christina Ryan Rodriguez (Dean of Enrollment Services) and Ben Olague (Outreach Specialist) some questions:

What is CaMP and what do the letters stand for?

Christina Ryan Rodriguez: The letters stand for Case Management Program. It's an outreach composed of helpful GWC staff whose mission is to connect with every single GWC student attending full- or part-time or even taking just one class. We are here to help!

Do students need to enroll in CaMP?

Ben Olague: Students are automatically included in the program for preliminary support. However, should a need arise for resource support students can also be referred to CaMP with the form here (goldenwestcollege.edu/case-management-program).

How does CaMP help students?

CRR: CaMP can connect you to campus resources you need to succeed at GWC. A team member will check in with you via text, phone, and email to see how you are doing. Feel free to text back and we will get back to you within 48 hours. Stressed out about exams and midterms? CaMP Reps can connect you with tutors. Feeling a little overwhelmed or sad? CaMP Reps can get you connected with teletherapy at the Student Health center. Did your computer die? CaMP Reps can help you get a Chromebook loaned to you so you don't miss a beat with your classes.

Who are the CaMP representatives and how do they know so much?

BO: CaMP representatives are current GWC classified staff, faculty, managers, and administrators. They know about GWC because they ARE GWC.

Do students get their own personal CaMP representative?

CRR: Yes, each student is assigned a GWC Campus Rep that

they can reach out to via text anytime for assistance.

So I can call or text my CaMP representative at home, day or night?

BO: CaMP representatives can be contacted by email or text and they will respond within 48 hours. If students prefer to speak by phone that can be arranged as well.

Is there any question too difficult for a CaMP representative?

CRR: If your CaMP Rep doesn't know the answer, they will find it or get you connected to the person who does! No (student-related) question is too hard for this team. Tutoring, food resources, technology needs... Try us! We are here to help!




