MAKE A PLAN...

With Academic Counseling and the Transfer Center

PRIORITY REGISTRATION

Get the classes you need at the times you want with Priority Registration. Just follow the three easy steps below. The best news...? You only need to complete the Priority Registration process once!

Step 1. Submit your My Academic Plan (MAP) online. This will get your English and Math placement done, as well as help you identify your Program of Study. For most students, this will also prompt Counseling to complete at least a first semester Student Educational Plan (SEP) for you. (See Step 2.)

Step 2. Meet with a Counselor. All students who want to secure Priority Registration must have a Counselor-approved SEP on file. To make an appointment, visit the Counseling Virtual Front Desk, or call (714) 895-8799.

Step 3. Complete the Online Orientation. Once you finish MAP, you will be directed to complete the Online Orientation.

Finish these steps by October 1st and you will be guaranteed Priority Registration for the Spring semester!

TRANSFER CENTER

The Transfer Center helps students transition from the community college to a four-year institution. Our team is here to make sure you have everything you need for admission to your school of choice. Beyond course equivalents and admission requirements, we have options to guarantee your admission to several University of California (UC), California State University (CSU), private/out-of-state, and Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCU).

We also connect you with representatives from the four-year universities for one-on-one appointments! We will be hosting a <u>Virtual Transfer Fair</u> on Wednesday, October 14.

Most campuses require students • to apply one year prior to the term they want to enter, so it is important to plan ahead. September is the Transfer Admission • Guarantee (TAG) period for the UC system. The CSU transfer application process begins October • 1, and November 1 begins the UC transfer application process for Fall 2021. I work very closely with the 30-40 students in our NextUp & Guardian Scholars programs and it always makes my day



when they send me a message checking in with me and just saying hi. It doesn't matter what kind of day I am having, when one of our students reaches out to say hi, I feel instantly happier. It shows that the work we do is a lot more than just transactional and that is a great reminder of why I love this work.






