THE GWC LIBRARY: It's Not Just for Books

The campus may be closed right now, but the GWC Library has positioned itself to offer a variety of its resources online for students. For example:

- 1. The library offers 24/7 access** to [eBooks](#), [streaming videos](#), and online articles, via its [library database collection](#). Students simply have to [log-in](#) with their Coast/MyGWC username and password.
- 2. The librarians have created supplementary research guides** that offer a general overview of the

Campus Resources/ Navigating College

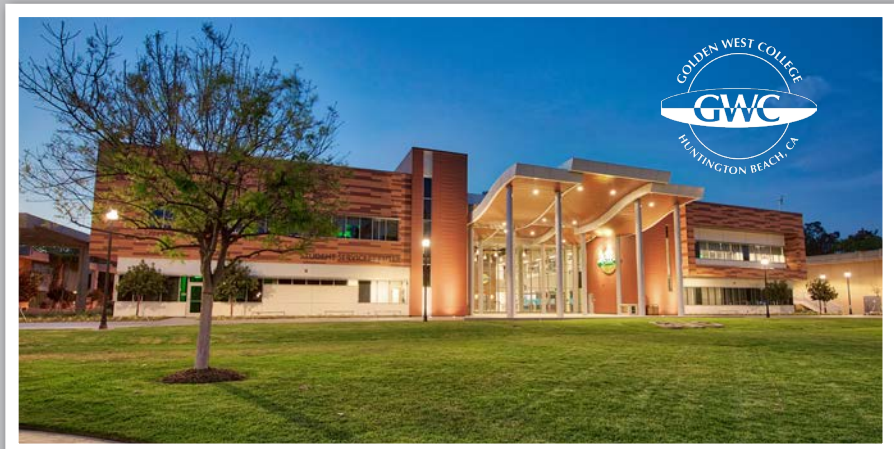
