**CSU FULLERTON:** Three programs available at this campus: Communications, Communication Studies, Communicative Disorders

A) Communications. Options available in: Advertising, Entertainment & Tourism, Journalism (Broadcast, Print, Visual), and Public Relations. The Accrediting Council on Education in Journalism and Mass Communication has set forth strict guidelines for majors in communications. It is imperative that students review the CSUF catalog for additional requirements.

B) Communication Studies. Options available in: Argumentation Debate, Intercultural Communication, Interpersonal Communication, Organizational Communication, Communication Studies (General)

C) Communicative Disorders. No lower division preparation for Communicative Disorders.

**CSU LONG BEACH:** All majors at this campus are impacted. Please see counselor for admission and selection criteria for this major. Three programs available at this campus: Communication Studies, Speech Language Pathology, and Journalism.

A). Communication Studies: Local Admission: Minimum 2.5 GPA required and completion of major preparation coursework above with a 2.5 GPA for admission. Options available in Communication Studies General, Interpersonal and Organizational Communication, and Communication, Culture, and Public Affairs.

B). Speech-Language Pathology: Local Admission: Minimum 3.5 GPA required and completion of major preparation coursework above with a 3.0 GPA.

3.1: Recommended science preparation: One Biological Science course (BIOL G221 recommended), One Physical Science course (CHEM G110 or PHYS G120 recommended), One Social Science course (ANTH G100 or PSYC G100, or SOC G100 recommended).

C). BA in Journalism: Local Admission: Minimum 2.0 GPA required and completion of major preparation coursework above. Additional major courses to be completed after transfer.
