<p><b>Proficiency or advanced level coursework in a second language and proficiency in English.</b> Must be able to speak, read, and write in the language. Language identified by Chancellor’s office:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>American Sign Language</li> <li>Arabic</li> <li>Chinese, including its various dialects</li> <li>French</li> <li>Farsi</li> <li>Russian</li> <li>Spanish</li> <li>Tagalog</li> </ul> <p>The various languages of the Indian subcontinent, African continent, and Southeastern Asia</p> <p><b>Max Points= 2</b></p>	<p><b>Proof must be provided by the student of second language proficiency by one of the following:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>transcripts showing completion of 2 years of high school in same language with a “C” or better</li> <li>1 year in college through the intermediate level or higher (Level 185 at GWC or higher)</li> <li>AP score of 3 or higher or SAT Subject test score in the language</li> </ul> <p><b>A letter providing your ability to speak a second language or native language will not be accepted for the multi-criteria points.</b></p>

Multi-criteria: Work Experience
<p><b>Current direct patient care experience in a healthcare setting either volunteer or paid within 3 years.</b> (Educational/ Clinical hours for other programs do not qualify as volunteer hours)</p> <p><b>REQUIRED: Letter from organization on letterhead stating hours completed, timeframe of completion, title, and type of relevant work performed and/or copy of license.</b></p> <p><b>Any combination of the columns below can be submitted for a total maximum of 20 points.</b></p>
