

Relay Quick Start Guide for Students

Welcome to TechSmith Relay! The Coast Community College District has a tool for creating and sharing videos and it is integrated with Canvas. Below you will find instructions on how to access your TechSmith Relay account and begin creating videos.

What is Relay?

Relay gives you an easy way to create and store video content for your classes. You have access to:

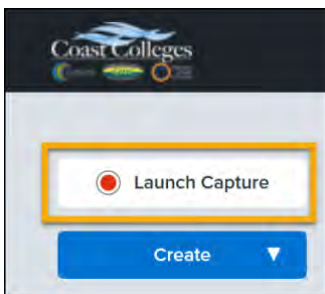
- An online video library where you can store as many videos as you like.
- A web-based recorder to easily create new videos of yourself and your screen.
- A simple way to add these videos right into Canvas.
- A free mobile app (**TechSmith Fuse**) that allows you to import any video content from your phone right into your Relay Library.

Step 1: Login

1. Go to [Coast District Relay login](https://coastdistrict.techsmithrelay.com/). URL: <https://coastdistrict.techsmithrelay.com/>
2. Click **Sign In** and login using your MyCoast username and password.

Step 2: Record a video!

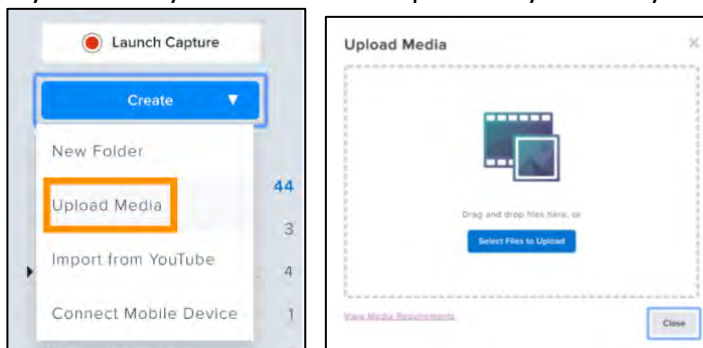
- From your personal Relay library, click the **Launch Capture** button to create a NEW video.



**Note: You will need to download the recorder the first time you use it.*

Step 3: Upload Videos

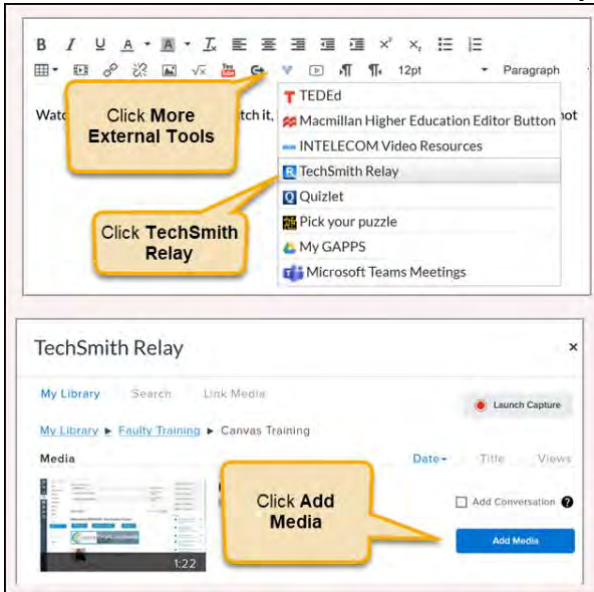
- If you already have a video to upload to your Relay library, go to **Create > Upload Media**.



Step 4: Share

Embed a video in a Canvas discussion

- Click **More External Tools > TechSmith Relay**, locate your video and click **Add Media**.



Submit a video to a Canvas assignment

- If a Canvas assignment accepts a text entry submission, then you can embed a video from your Relay library using the steps above.

Share a video using a link

- In Relay, locate your video and click **Share > Get a Link > Copy**.



Import a Video from a Mobile Device to Your Relay Library
